

**City of Worthing
Special Meeting
Approved Minutes
Municipal Election Vote Canvas
April 12, 2017**

Mayor Eric Saugstad called the special meeting of the canvassing of the vote to order at 5:30 PM in the Worthing Civic Center. Answering roll call were Commissioners Crystal Jacobson, Ryan Schlieman and Sheri Lund. Commissioner Eric Bunkers was absent with notice. Also present was Finance Officer Linda Hunnel.

The Worthing City Commission, acting as an Election Board, canvassed the votes of the April 11th Municipal Election.

Mayor Saugstad declared Bradley J. Hazuka winner in the City Mayoral, 5 year term race between Hazuka and Cody J. Roth, with 77 votes for Hazuka and 76 votes for Roth.

Mayor Saugstad declared John Ganschow winner in the City Commission, 3 year term race between Ganschow and Eric Bunkers, with 83 votes for Ganschow and 66 votes for Bunkers.

Motion by Jacobson, second by Schlieman that Bradley J. Hazuka is duly elected to the Worthing City Commission as Mayor, 5 (five) year term and that John Ganschow is duly elected to the Worthing City Commission as Commissioner, 3 (three) year term. Schlieman seconded. Motion carried, all voting aye.

There being no further business before the commission, Jacobson made a motion to adjourn at 5:55 pm. Schlieman seconded. Motion carried, all voting aye. The next regular meeting of the Worthing City Commission is Monday April 24, 2017 at 7pm in the Worthing Civic Center.
